You will ideally have post-qualification experience of working with children with social, emotional, communication and mental health difficulties, although applications from newly qualified music therapists are welcomed if there is relevant placement experience.

The ability to work autonomously and yet be able to work effectively and collaboratively as part of a team is important. Confidence in working collaboratively within the multidisciplinary teams at each school is essential to the success of the service. Applicants should possess excellent organisational and communication skills and have significant experience of report writing and evaluation. You will be pro-active in communicating with schools, clients, carers and management.

Experience of running choirs and singing groups is also desirable but not essential. Alongside the music therapy work there may be opportunities to run well-being singing groups and song-writing sessions as part of a wider singing project offer.
